Senior Investigative Trial Counsel/Deputy Director

The State of New Mexico Judicial Standards Commission, located in Albuquerque, is accepting applications for a Senior Investigative Trial Counsel/Deputy Director, an exempt (not classified), at-will, full-time position. Salary range \$33.374/hr - \$52.146/hr, commensurate with experience. The Senior Investigative Trial Counsel investigates and prosecutes matters before the Commission involving the removal, retirement, or discipline of judges; presents oral and written argument before the New Mexico Supreme Court; assists the Executive Director with the management, supervision and administration of the agency and staff.

Applicant must be licensed to practice law in New Mexico; be in good standing in New Mexico and all other states where law licensure held; and have no professional disciplinary history. A minimum of ten (10) years of experience in the practice of law required, of which three (3) years must have been in a staff supervisory role. Advanced knowledge, exceptional skill, and proven abilities in criminal or administrative prosecution is strongly preferred. Fluency in Spanish a plus.

Position requires thorough knowledge of New Mexico law, court rules and procedures, appellate procedure, federal law, Code of Judicial Conduct, and the Rules of Professional Conduct; strong research, writing, and communications skills; discretion, sound judgment, and adaptability to frequently changing priorities and high stress. Specialized knowledge in administrative and constitutional law is desirable. Successful candidate must possess, exhibit, and maintain exemplary ethics. Hiring dependent on successful completion of a post-offer background check.
