13                   Stipulation Agreement and Consent to Discipline and the response of respondent,  
14                   Hon. Warren G. Walton, and the Court having considered the foregoing and being  
15                   sufficiently advised; Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice Barbara J. Vigil,  
16                   Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, and Justice David K.  
17                   Thomson concurring;

18                   NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion to Enforce Terms  
19                   of Paragraph 15 of Stipulation Agreement and Consent to Discipline is

21                   IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent, Hon. Warren Walton, shall be


1 suspended without pay for three weeks, beginning on March 13, 2019; and
