## ORDER

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon the joint stipulation to temporary suspension filed by the New Mexico Judicial Standards Commission and Respondent Judge Robert E. Robles, this Court having considered the stipulation and being otherwise sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Charles W. Daniels, Justice Patricio M. Serna, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Richard C. Bosson, and Justice Edward L. Chávez concurring,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties to temporary suspension hereby is approved and Judge Robles is suspended without pay, effective Wednesday, February 16, 2011, until resolution of this Inquiry or until further order of this Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in light of all the circumstances, including Judge Robles's earlier voluntary request to be allowed to take leave without pay, the suspension shall be without pay.
