ORDER

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon motion to accept stipulation to permanent retirement from judicial office effective June 1, 2011, and consent to discipline, and the Court having considered said motion and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Charles W. Daniels, Justice Patricio M. Serna, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Richard C. Bosson, and Justice Edward L. Chávez concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED and ROBERT E. ROBLES shall be disciplined as follows:

- 1. Respondent agrees to permanently retire as Judge of the New Mexico Court of Appeals effective close of business on June 1, 2011;
- 2. Respondent agrees to never again hold, become a candidate for, run for, or stand for election to any New Mexico judicial office in the future;.
- 3. Respondent shall never seek, accept appointment to, or serve pro tempore for any New Mexico judicial office in the future; and

4. Respondent shall accept a Formal Reprimand from this Court concerning the conduct admitted in the *Stipulation to Permanent Retirement and Consent to Discipline*. The Formal Reprimand shall be published in the *Bar Bulletin*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent and the Commission shall bear their own costs and expenses in this matter; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the file shall be unsealed pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
