## **ORDER**

WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court upon petition for discipline upon stipulation, and the Court having considered said petition and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Charles W. Daniels, Justice Patricio M. Serna, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Richard C. Bosson, and Justice Edward L. Chávez concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition hereby is GRANTED and JOHN SANCHEZ shall be disciplined as follows:

- 1. Respondent agrees to complete a twelve-month supervised probation and formal mentorship. The Commission shall recommend the probation supervisor/mentor, for consideration and appointment by this Court. The probation supervisor/mentor shall report on the progress and outcome of the mentorship to this Court and to the Judicial Standards Commission;
- Respondent agrees to attend all sections and complete a course approved by the Judicial Standards Commission from the National Judicial College. Respondent agrees that he will not teach any portion of

the approved course from the National Judicial College. Respondent shall pay all costs, including travel, lodging, meals, and tuition associated with attending and completing this course.

- 3. Respondent shall receive a formal reprimand from this Court concerning the conduct admitted in the *Stipulation Agreement and Consent to Discipline*. The reprimand shall not be published in the *Bar Bulletin*;
- 4. Respondent shall abide by all terms of the *Stipulation Agreement and Consent to Discipline*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent and the Commission shall bear their own costs and expenses in this matter; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the file shall be unsealed pursuant to Rule 27-104(B) NMRA.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
